## Decorating

The liners for the flower vases or wrought iron stands may not be removed from the Cathedral for weddings. Forty-four ounce soft drink cups (fast food chains have them) will fit our vases. They may be spray painted black for the stands or any color you wish if they are to be placed in vases for the reception. Other flower arrangements may be used on the altar, in the vestibule, on tables, etc. and may be taken to the reception. Flowers, sprays, etc. **may not be taped or wired to the pews.** Ribbons or floral pew holders may be used. Hanging baskets may be placed on the rafters with guidance from the Altar Guild.

No confetti, rice or birdseed inside or outside of the church.

Only artificial or silk flowers may be scattered to precede the bride down the aisle. No real flowers petals as they are slippery and give off oils which may then be ground into the wood floor.
